**God is in the future**

If God is calling you, to what are you being called?

The Kingdom of God is not like the kingdoms of the earth. In what ways?

When Jesus calls you to the future, to what things do you say, "no thank you, Jesus"?

If sin is the refusal to grow/evolve, the refusal to become more like God, then in what ways is our church sinning?

**I Am Who I Am**

Jesus came to example for us who God is, so who is the God that Jesus reveals to us? How does this God differ from the in-the-past, dictator, potentate, chess master God?

**The New Frontier**

What does the Kingdom of God here and now look like for you? What is your church's role in the Kingdom?

What is the mission of your church? How does it reflect Jesus and the Kingdom of God? What action does your church's mission call you to?

What do you hope your church can be?

To be a Christian is to be with Jesus at the frontier of the future. What does this statement mean to you?

If you envision God beckoning to you from the future, how does that change your understanding of God?
