Community Size

10,400 residents nestled near Yellowstone National Park's East Entrance and the Shoshone National Forest.

Essential Services

Full-service hospital, Search and Rescue, K-12 school system, and mix of local shops and restaurants

The town is large enough to provide essential services, including Cody Regional Health (a full-service hospital that attracts top medical professionals), three elementary schools, a middle school, a high school, and an alternative high school. Cody also supports a mix of locally owned shops, restaurants, and small businesses alongside larger retailers. Yellowstone Regional Airport is located in Cody and serves all of northwest Wyoming.

Cody has a vibrant cultural community including several museums, public library, recreation center with an indoor ice rink, local community theaters, as well as a variety of lively music venues.

The community is friendly, safe, and family-oriented. Billings, Montana, is 90 minutes away, offering expanded medical and cultural resources and additional air service. Cody is known for its Western heritage, welcoming atmosphere, and quality of life. Our parish reflects that character: independent, resilient, and deeply connected to the land and to each other.

The Main Church

Where most Sunday services are held, supported by a vocal choir, bell choir, and pipe organ, serving as the heart of our worship life.



The 'Poker Church'

A smaller, historic chapel often used for seasonal Taizé services, offering intimate worship experiences.



Wayfarers Chapel

Located along the stunning Northfork Highway, Wayfarers offers outdoor worship during the summer months and welcomes all travelers.

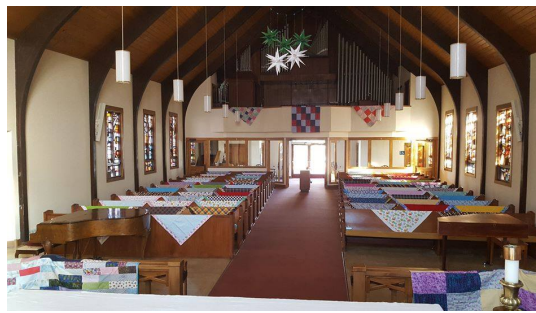


Memorial Garden

Worship Life



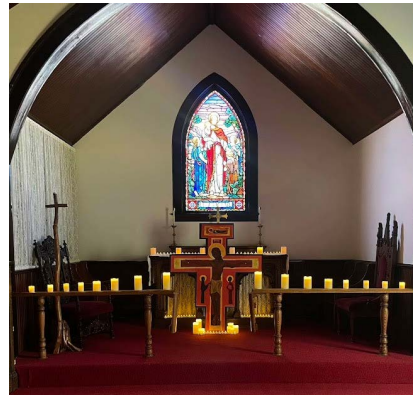
Our worship is rooted in the Book of Common Prayer and enriched by music, scripture, and sacrament. Throughout the year, variations in the service occur and special programming often is added, such as our Recovery Eucharist, Holy Eucharist for the Prevention of Suicide, and Season of Creation.

⚠ Survey Findings

Many parishioners expressed gratitude for the variety of worship opportunities. At the same time, they voiced a desire for worship that is **more challenging, thought-provoking, and spiritually engaging**. A new rector will find both a strong worship tradition and a congregation eager to go deeper.

✔ Survey Findings

Parishioners strongly support service and outreach, but they want **clearer connections between service and faith**. Opportunities exist to more intentionally link outreach with discipleship and scripture.

The Voice of the Congregation: Survey Results

The RenewalWorks Spiritual Life Inventory revealed both strengths and challenges.

Strengths

- Strong commitment to prayer, especially intercessory prayer
- Service to those in need is highly valued
- High hunger for spiritual growth – members want to go deeper in faith



Opportunity

The survey made clear: our people are not complacent. They are eager for a rector who will inspire, challenge, and guide them. Bold, church-wide initiatives – such as **Bible engagement, Morning and Evening Prayer, and teaching about the Eucharist** – would be welcomed.

- Increasing church's role in spiritual growth
- Identifying pathway for spiritual growth or next steps
- Providing increased challenging and thought-provoking worship
- Encouraging scripture engagement outside worship

Improving discipleship pathways for spiritual growth and next steps in faith



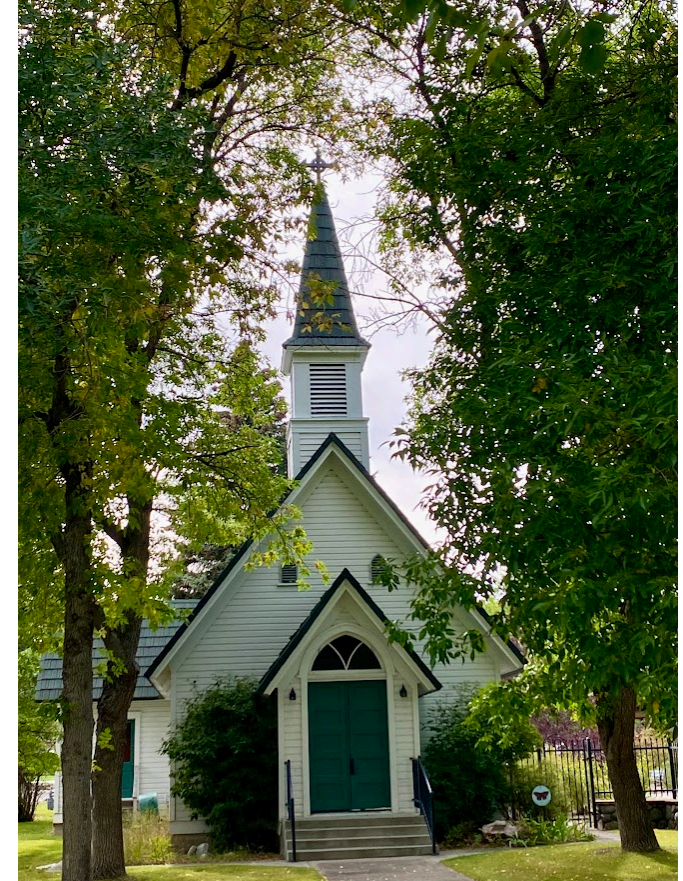
Generational Renewal

Leader Developer

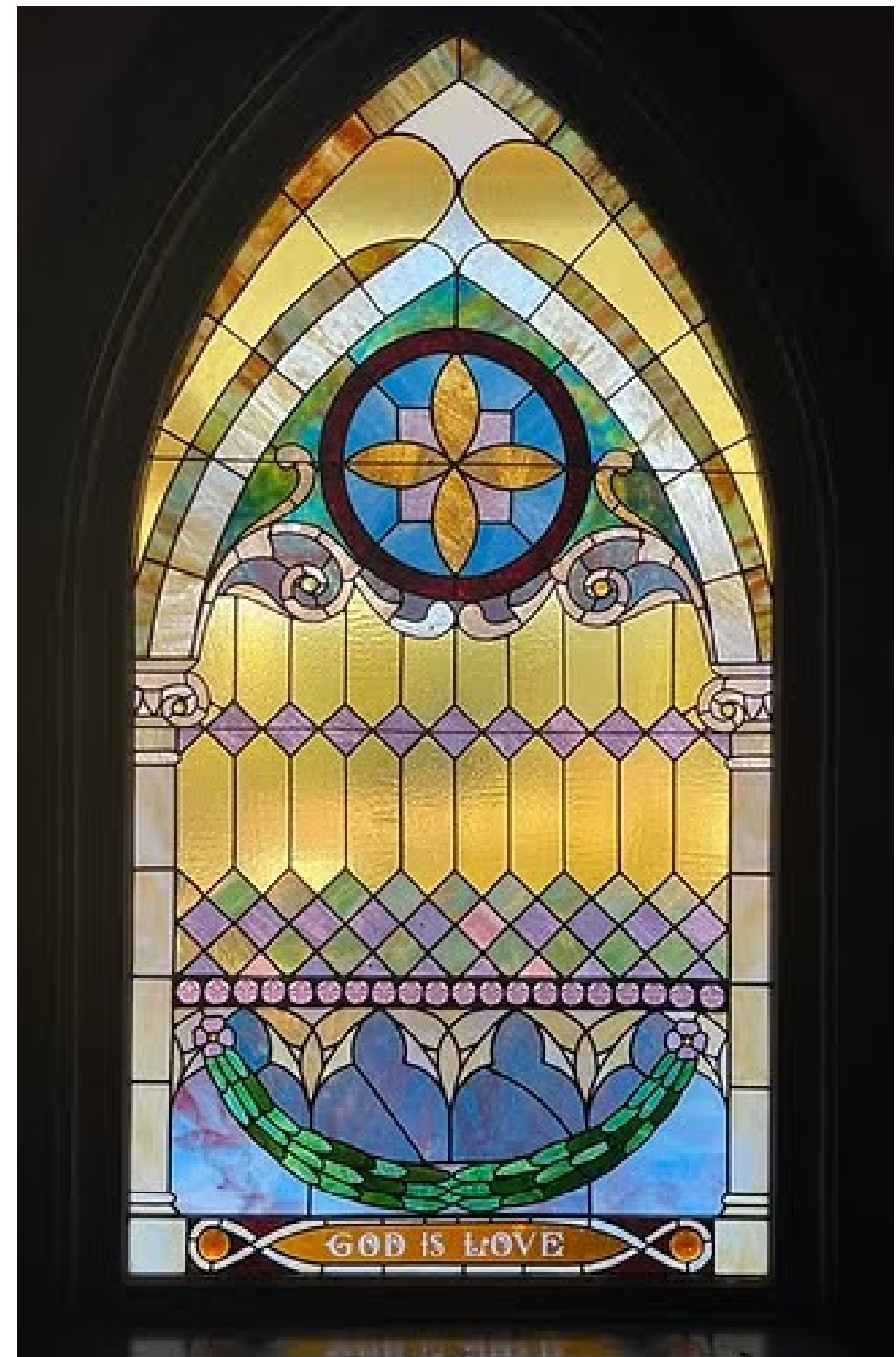
Equipping lay leaders and empowering ministry throughout the congregation
