If your assigned date is not workable for your congregation, we ask that you identify another worshipping community with a scheduled visitation weekend that does work for you, coordinate a switch directly with them, and confirm that both communities agree to the change. Please notify the diocesan office of the updated date no later than 6 weeks in advance.

CUSTOMARY FOR BISHOP VISITATIONS

effective August 1, 2025

Timeline & Overview

- Visitations typically span Saturday-Sunday.
- We prioritize:
 - o Congregational needs and anniversaries.
 - o Opportunities for baptism, confirmation, reception, or reaffirmation.
 - A rotation schedule that ensures all congregations are visited during an 18-month span.

Saturday Schedule

- Meeting with Vestry or Church Leadership
 - o Focus on the congregation's vision, mission, goals, and challenges.
 - Bishop Todd is especially interested in:
 - One project/ministry you're excited about.
 - Honest reflection on where support is needed.
 - o Format may be conversation, Q&A, or presentation by lay leaders.

Sunday Schedule

- Arrival
 - o Bishop Todd will arrive 30-45 minutes before the first service.
- Worship
 - Bishop Todd typically preaches.
 - He is happy to **preside**, but this is **not required**.
 - o Please provide a bulletin and liturgy outline at least 2 weeks in advance.
 - Readings: Please submit the readings along with the Bible translation (e.g., NRSV, ESV) at least two weeks in advance.
 - Liturgical color: follow the season including liturgies of confirmation, reception, and reaffirmation. If baptism(s) are scheduled, please use white.
- Confirmations, Receptions, Reaffirmations, or Baptisms
 - o For baptisms of infants and young children, clergy pray the Thanksgiving over the Water and conduct the baptism by water with Bishop Todd chrismating (anointing with oil or water). Any older children or adults will be baptized by Bishop Todd, including chrismation (this unitive act by the bishop constitutes both baptism and confirmation.
 - For any of these rites, inform the Bishop's Office at least 1 month in advance.
 - The Bishop will meet with candidates **30 minutes** before worship.
- Blessing of Chrism
 - o If needed, please have oil prepared and let the Bishop know in advance.
- Following Worship
 - Bishop Todd will remain after worship for fellowship with the congregation, greeting parishioners and participating informally in post-service hospitality.
 - When possible, a meal or gathering with clergy and their spouses will follow. Alternatively, this meal may be scheduled for Saturday evening.
 - o The Bishop has no dietary restrictions.

Scheduling Adjustments

- If your assigned weekend is not feasible, you may **coordinate a switch** with another parish directly.
- Both parishes must agree to the swap, and notification must be sent to Genie Osburn, Communications Manager, at genie@episcopalwy.org at least 6 weeks before the scheduled date.
- This ensures proper coordination for Bishop Todd's travel, materials, and communications.

- Please assign a volunteer photographer for the day.
- Photos should be candid and respectful, especially during liturgy.

Other Logistics

- **Bishop's Vestments**: Bishop Todd will wear a **rochet and chimere**.
- Discretionary Fund Offering:
 - Envelopes may be provided.
 - The worshipping community may direct loose offerings to the Bishop's Discretionary Fund, if desired.
 - Any Discretionary Funds collected should be consolidated into one check and forwarded to the Diocesan Office - make checks payable to "Bishop's Discretionary Fund."
- Documentation:
 - Please send all materials, bulletins, and lists of candidates at least two weeks in advance.
- **Certificates**: A sufficient number of <u>signed</u> certificates of baptism, confirmation, or reception will be sent to the worshipping community for completion by local leadership.
- Parish Register: It is required by Canon that the bishop review the Parish Register during the visitation. Thanks in advance for having these appropriate registers available for review.
